Taking Care of Your Radios

Follow these golden rules to keep your radios working efficiently and safely:-

1. Always switch equipment OFF when it is not in use. Radios must be switched off when they are charging.
2. If a radio or charger fails, or the power supply/cable becomes damaged, return it. NEVER attempt to repair it yourself.
3. Keep cables out of harm's way.
 - Clear of the work area.
 - Away from sharp edges and water
 - Beware of trip hazards.
4. Keep equipment dry.
 - Avoid using radios in very damp or wet conditions; perhaps consider a carry case or aquapak.
(If your radio is submersible always refer to manufacturers guidelines.)
5. Handle equipment with care.
 - Avoid dropping/knocking your radios.
 - Keep all equipment away from harmful substances including dust, gas and liquid.
